Agenda	<p>To consider and approve the guidelines for implementation of MOOCS Courses</p> <p>The University has adopted the UGC (Credit Framework for online learning courses through SWAYAM) Regulation 2016 in 14th meeting of the Academic Council held on 13th April, 2018.</p> <p>The students of the University are allowed to pursue MOOCs courses through SWAYAM platform. In order to streamline the pursue of MOOCs courses and recognition of the credits earned, the Dean, Research & Development has proposed following guidelines:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Guidelines for the implementation of MOOC Course</p> <p>As per the UGC guideline all Head of the Departments should ensure that students should take 20-40% course from SWAYAM platform. Students has to be properly guided to register themselves for such type of courses. The mentors of each department should take care of the same. Once the students get registered to a course, they have to follow the guidelines given below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. One teacher should be assigned by the Head of the Department to look after each course. It is advisable that the concerned teacher has undergone the same course. 2. They should abide by the Rules and Regulations of the organizations offering the course such as NPTEL, e-Pathsala, SWAYAM etc. 3. They have to qualify the test as per the guidelines. The test result (pass or fail) has to be submitted to the Examination Section.



	<p>4. If a student fails in any course, he/she has to reappear in the same course offered by the same organization subsequently. If a student takes course in the even semester and fails, he/she may pursue/register in the same subject in the Odd Semester provided the same organization is offering the course. If it is not offered in the odd semester, then the student has to wait for the next even semester to get himself/herself registered and complete the course.</p> <p>5. If the student unable to complete the course in the stipulated time period as prescribed by the said organization, then the Department has to take steps to conduct the examination in house to compensate the loss.</p> <p>6. In case of discontinuity of the subject, the department should take the responsibility to register the failed students and conduct the sessional examination and final examination in house.</p> <p>7. For any other instances, application should be sent to the Dean, Academic Affairs. Dean, Academic Affairs along with CoE should take a decision as per the situation within the examination guidelines of CUJ.</p> <p>The matter was placed before the Academic Council for consideration and approval</p>

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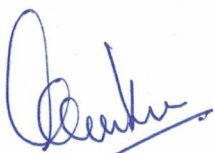

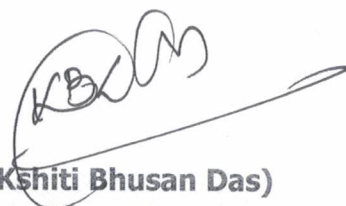
